

DRIVEREDSAFETY.COM GUIDE TO GETTING YOUR LICENSE

All steps assume you've enrolled in both the class AND in-car instruction.

1

STEP ONE

COMPLETE YOUR CLASS

- Remember students have 120 days from enrollment to finish!

2

STEP TWO

OBTAIN YOUR LEARNER'S PERMIT

You will need to bring your CDE form when you go to the BMV. Your CDE form was attached to your enrollment e-mail.

Check your online completion e-mail for more details on what ID is needed.

3

STEP THREE

UPDATE YOUR ACCOUNT WITH YOUR PERMIT NUMBER

- Add your permit number to your DriverEdSafety.com account under Profile.

! You must update your account to get placed on the waitlist for a driving instructor

STEP FOUR

WAIT FOR YOUR IN-CAR INSTRUCTOR ASSIGNMENT E-MAIL

It may take up to 12 weeks to receive your instructor assignment email

5

STEP FIVE

SCHEDULE YOUR IN-CAR LESSONS

- Once you receive your instructor assignment e-mail, you may begin scheduling your lessons.

It is important to practice driving with your parents between each lesson

6

STEP SIX

COMPLETE YOUR IN-CAR LESSONS

You have 90 days to complete your lessons

7

STEP SEVEN

REQUEST YOUR ROAD SKILLS TEST

- After you complete your in-car lessons, you can purchase your road skills test through the portal.

! You must be 15 years and 6 months old to schedule the test with DriverEdSafety.

8

STEP EIGHT

OBTAIN YOUR LICENSE

Remember to bring your completion certificate(s) to the BMV
ONLINE STUDENTS: You will need to bring two certificates

You must be 16 and 3 months and have held your permit for 180 days to obtain your license
